Can students pre-register for their courses? <i>Yes. Students are provided with log-on details for Studentweb by SMS before the registration opens: https://www.uio.no/english/studies/international-students/before-arrival/username-and-password/</i> 3. What are registration deadlines? <i>Students must register their courses within 1 February for courses in the spring semester and 1 September for courses in the autumn semester.</i> 4. How can students access course syllabus? <i>The course descriptions contain detailed descriptions: http://www.uio.no/english/studies/courses/</i> 5. What is the minimum/maximum number of courses a student may register in? <i>There is no maximum, but the regular full-time course load per semester is 30 ECTS. Most courses are 10 ECTS each, so most students take three 10 credit courses.</i> 6. If problems arise during their registration, who can students contact for help? <i>Student must contact their host faculty. Each faculty and department has an international coordinator who can help with these issues.</i>
