Guidelines for Admission for MEXT Scholarship of Japanese Government

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1. Overview

Graduate School of Engineering at Tokai University was selected by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) to award "Monbukagakusho Scholarships in FY 2024 The International Priority Graduate Programs (PGP)". For the next three years, Course of Mechanical Engineering, Graduate School of Engineering is accepting applications for the program. The detail of the program and the application procedure are as follows:

Name of the program: Cultivation of next-generation engineers for advanced human-robot symbiosis in ASEAN countries.

Course: Course of Mechanical Engineering, Graduate School of Engineering

Admission quota: 3

2. Application Qualifications and Requirements

(1) Nationality

Applicants must have the nationality of a country that has diplomatic relations with Japan. An applicant who has Japanese nationality at the time of application is not eligible, in principle. However, persons with dual nationality who hold Japanese nationality and whose place of residence at the time of application is outside of Japan are eligible to apply as long as they choose the nationality of the other country and renounce their Japanese nationality by the date of their arrival in Japan. (the acquisition of student status). Priority is given to international students from the following regions of focus.

ASEAN: Brunei Darussalam, Singapore, Myanmar, Laos, Thailand, Cambodia, Vietnam, Malaysia, Philippines, and Indonesia

(2) Age

Those who were born on or after April 2, 1990 in principle.

Exceptions are limited to cases in which MEXT deems that the applicant could not apply within the eligible age limit due to the situation or circumstances of the applicant's country (military service obligation, loss of educational opportunities due to disturbances of war, etc.) Personal circumstances (financial situation, family circumstances, state of health, circumstances related to applicant's university or place of employment, etc.) will not be considered for exceptions.

(3) Academic background

Applicants must satisfy the conditions for admission to either a master's or doctoral course at a Japanese graduate school. (Applicants who will certainly satisfy them at the time of enrollment are eligible.)

(4) Majors

Applicants should apply for the field of study they majored in at university or its related field. Moreover, the fields of study must be subjects which applicants will be able to study and research at the



accepting universities.

(5) Language proficiency

Those who have proficiency in either Japanese or English, and who also meet one of the following requirements.

Japanese

- ① Applicants must pass with N2 or higher in the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) at the time of application.
- ② Applicants must complete curriculums that meet the conditions for admission to master's or doctoral courses at Japanese graduate schools using Japanese as the main language.
- 3 Applicants are regarded by the accepting universities as having Japanese language ability equivalent to or better than 1.

English

- ① Applicants must pass or achieve scores in English language proficiency tests that correspond to B2 or higher level in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) at the time of application.
- ② Applicants must complete school curriculums that meet the conditions for admission in masters' or doctoral courses at a Japanese graduate school by using English as the main language.
- 3 Applicants are regarded by the accepting universities as having English language ability equivalent to or better than 1.

(6) Working language

English is the principal language used for giving classes and supervising students' research.

(7) Health

Applicants who are judged by the university to have no physical or mental conditions hindering the applicant's study in Japan.

(8) Arrival in Japan

Those who can enter Japan between September 1st, to 15th, 2025, in principle.

Excluding cases in which MEXT deems as unavoidable circumstances, the applicant must withdraw from this scholarship program if the applicant cannot arrive in Japan by the end of the specified period above. If an applicant will arrive in Japan before or after the specified period due to personal circumstances, travel expenses will not be paid.

(9) Visa Requirement / Status of Residence

An applicant shall, in principle, newly obtain a "Student" visa at the Japanese diplomatic mission located in the applicant's country of nationality, and enter Japan with the residence status of "Student." Please also note that if a grantee arrives in Japan without newly obtaining a "Student" visa, scholarship payments will be cancelled. Moreover, as the Japanese government requires pre-arrival tuberculosis screening for some countries, applicants obtaining a visa shall follow guidance at the overseas establishment of Japan located in the applicant's country of nationality.



* Visa requirements and status of residence for domestic recommenders

For those whose current status of residence is not "Student," applicants must change their status of residence to "Student" at the local Immigration Services Agency in Japan by time of registration as students at the accepting university. Even in cases of having other statuses of residence ("Permanent Resident," "Long Term Resident", etc.), applicants must change their status to "Student" and begin their courses of study as Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship students. It is important to note that applications for "Permanent Resident" or "Long Term Resident" status after status of Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship student ends, may not be granted as a matter of course. Also, if studies as Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship students begin without changing status of residence to "Student," scholarships will be canceled.

For those whose current status of residence is "Student," they must complete the renewal procedures before the expiration of their periods of stay. Additionally, in the event of changes in school enrollment, notification must be submitted pursuant to the provisions of Article 19-16 of the Immigration-Control and Refugee-Recognition Act.

(10) Non-eligibility

Those who meet any one of the following conditions are ineligible. If identified as ineligible after being selected as a scholarship student, the student must withdraw from the scholarship.

- 1) Those who are military personnel or military civilian employees;
- ② Those who cannot arrive in Japan by the date specified by MEXT or the accepting university;
- ③ Those who are previous grantees of Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship programs (including those who withdraw from the scholarship program after acquisition of student status). However, this does not apply to those who wish to apply for Research Students program and meet any one of the following conditions. In addition, since the Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students does not apply to the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship programs, the previous grantees can apply.
 - those who have at least three years of educational or work experience following the end of the payment of the previous scholarship and the start of this scholarship;
 - the past grantees of Japanese Studies Students program who have graduated or are going to graduate from universities in their home countries, Japan-Korea Joint Government Scholarship Program for the Students in Science and Engineering Departments and Young Leaders' Program;
 - those who have obtained or are expected to obtain a degree as undergraduate students of the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship programs (university recommendation/special selection).
- Those who are currently also applying to another program under the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship system. This includes the programs for which scholarship payments will begin in FY2025;
- ⑤ Those who are planning to receive scholarship money from an organization other than MEXT



(including a government organization of the applicant's country) on top of the scholarship money provided by MEXT after the start of the scholarship payment (the acquisition of student status);

- ⑥ Those who are expected to graduate at the time of application and cannot satisfy the condition of academic background by the deadline given;
- Tholders of dual nationality at the time of application who cannot verify that they will give up Japanese nationality by the time of the arrival in Japan (the acquisition of student status);
- ® Those who plan to, from the time of application for the MEXT scholarship program, engage in long-term research (such as fieldwork or internship) outside Japan or plan to take a long-term leave of absence from the university;
- Those who have no intention to obtain a degree.

(11) Others

MEXT Scholarship will be granted those who are willing to contribute to mutual understanding between Japan and their home country by participating in activities at schools and communities during their study in Japan while contributing to the internationalization of Japan. They shall also make efforts to promote relations between the home country and Japan by maintaining close relations with the university attended after graduation, cooperating with the conducting of surveys and questionnaires, and cooperating with relevant projects and events conducted by the Japanese diplomatic mission after they return to their home countries.

3. PERIOD OF SCHOLARSHIP

In principle, the scholarship money will be paid for a period of two years from September 2025.

*Certain conditions must be fulfilled to receive the payment.

*It takes one to 1.5 months after arrival in Japan before the scholarship begins to be paid. Accordingly, grantees are advised to prepare at least 2,000 US dollars for living expenses that will be needed before the commencement of payments.

4. SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS

(1) Scholarship

The amounts listed below shall be paid depending on the course enrolled in. A supplemental regional allowance of 2,000 yen or 3,000 yen per month will be added to the monthly scholarship amount for the grantees studying or conducting research in specially designated regions. Due to the situation of the Japanese Government's budget, the amount of payment may be subject to change each fiscal year. If a grantee is absent from the university for an extended period, the scholarship shall be suspended for that period.

Regular students enrolled in master's or professional degree courses: 144,000 yen per month

(2) Travelling expenses

1 Transportation to Japan

MEXT will stipulate the travel schedule and route, and provide an airline ticket. However, MEXT



will not provide an airline ticket for cases of domestic recommenders. The airline ticket will be an economy-class ticket for the flight from the international airport closest to the grantee's residence (in principle, the country of nationality) to an international airport in Japan used on the normal route to the accepting university. The grantee shall bear at his/her own expense all costs related to domestic travel from the grantee's residence to the nearest international airport, airport taxes, airport usage fees, special taxes necessary for travel, travel expenses within Japan (including airline transit costs), travel insurance expenses, carry-on luggage or unaccompanied baggage expenses, etc. The grantee shall also bear at his/her own expense travel and lodging costs incurred in a third country if the grantee must travel to a third country before coming to Japan for visa purposes because there are no Japanese diplomatic missions in his/her country, and the Japanese diplomatic mission is closed in his/her country, or if there are no direct flights from the grantee's country of residence to Japan. MEXT will provide an economy-class airline ticket from the grantee's country of residence to the said third country, and from the third country to an international airport in Japan used on the normal route to the accepting university. In principle, the address given in the space for "Your address before departure for Japan" on the application form shall be recognized as the "residence," and the airline ticket will be arranged for a flight from the international airport nearest to that address. Except for cases when the grantee must travel to a third country to obtain a visa, MEXT will not provide an airline ticket for cases of travel to Japan from a country other than the grantee's country of residence due to the grantee's personal circumstances.

2 Transportation from Japan

Based on the application by the grantee, MEXT will provide an airline ticket to grantees who shall graduate or complete the accepting university and return to the home country by the end of the final month of the period of scholarship (See "2. PERIOD OF SCHOLARSHIP") designated by MEXT. MEXT shall provide an economy-class airline ticket from the international airport in Japan used for the normal route to and from the accepting university to the international airport (in principle, in the country of nationality) nearest to the returning grantee's residence. The grantee shall bear at his/her own expense all costs related to travel from the grantee's residence in Japan to the nearest international airport, airport taxes, airport usage fees, special taxes necessary for travel, travel expenses within the country of nationality (including airline transit costs), travel insurance expenses, carry-on luggage or unaccompanied baggage expenses, etc. If a grantee returns to the home country before the end of period of scholarship due to personal circumstances, or reasons stated in "4. SUSPENSION OF PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP," MEXT will not pay for the returning travel expenses. If a grantee continues to stay in Japan after the scholarship period has ended (ex. proceeding to further education or being employed in Japan), travel expenses for a temporary return will also not be paid.

(3) Education expenses

Fees for the entrance examination, matriculation, and tuition at universities must be paid by the accepting university.



XStudent Health Insurance Union Fee and Alumni Association Fee will be paid by student.

5. SUSPENSION OF PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Payment of the scholarship will be cancelled for the reasons given below. Should any of the following reasons apply, the grantee may be ordered to return a part of, or all of, the scholarship paid up to that time. Payment of the scholarship may also be stopped during the period up to the decision on the disposition of the matter.

- ① A grantee is determined to have made a false statement on his/her application;
- 2 A grantee violates any article of his/her pledge to the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology;
- 3 A grantee violates any Japanese laws and is sentenced and imprisoned for an indefinite period or for a period exceeding 1 year;
- 4 A grantee is suspended from his/her university or receives other punishment, or is removed from enrollment; as a disciplinary action in accordance with school regulations of the accepting institution;
- (5) It has been determined that it will be impossible for a grantee to complete the course within the standard period of study because of poor academic grades or suspension or absence from the university;
- 6 A grantee came to Japan without newly acquiring the "Student" residence status, or changed his/her residence status to one other than "Student." In case of domestic recommenders, they begin studies as Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship students with a status of residence other than "Student" or changed his/her residence status to one other than "Student."
- A grantee has received another scholarship (excluding those specified for research expenditures);
- A grantee proceeds to a more advanced level of education without receiving approval for an extension of the period of the scholarship;
- A grantee withdraws from his/her university or transfers to another university;
- ① A grantee's annual GPA is below 2.30 or the grading standard set by the university.

6. Application Procedures

(1) Application period

Monday, November 25, to Friday, December 20, 2024, (Japan Time)

[The application must arrive by the last day of the period.]

- * All times and dates indicated in this application shall refer to Japan Standard Time.
- (2) Documents to submit

The following documents must be submitted to the address indicated in 3) below and arrive by Friday, December 20, 2024. The documents shall be prepared in either Japanese or English. A Japanese or English translation shall be attached to a certificate which is written in neither of these languages.



- ① Application Form for the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship
 Print it on a single side of A4 paper and attach a photo (4.5 cm long by 3.5 cm wide) to it. A false statement or omission will result in disqualification.
- ② Field of Study and Research Plan specified by Japanese Government (MEXT)
 Print them on a single side of A4 paper. Describe your research plan for the Master's degree program.
- 3 Two photos (Separately from the one mentioned in ① above)
 Write your name (in block letters) on the back of each photo. (Unframed, 4cm long by 3cm wide; either color or black and white; must have been taken within the last three months; must be a clear shot of the upper body without a cap/hat taken from the front)
- 4 Latest academic transcript (master copy)
 Must be written on letterhead, be in a sealed envelope, and have an official seal or a signature on it.
- S A certificate of excellent academic performance from the last university attended Must be written on a letterhead, be in a sealed envelope, and have an official seal or a signature on it.
- (Expected) graduate certificate to satisfy application qualifications (master copy)
 If a grantee was expected to graduate (complete a program) when he/she passed the screening but fails to be qualified for graduate school by September 30, 2025, his/her admission will be canceled, and he/she will be disgualified from enrollment.
- Recommendation letter from the president/dean of the last university/graduate school attended A recommendation letter written in English to the Chancellor of Tokai University. Must be written on the letterhead of the university to which the president or dean belongs, be in a sealed envelope, and have an official seal or a signature on it.
- ® Proof of language proficiency (photocopy)
 Those who meet either of the following requirements on Japanese or English.
 Japanese: Those who have passed the N2 or higher level of the Japanese Language Proficiency
 Test (JLPT)
 - English: Those who have obtained qualifications or a proficiency test score that is equivalent to or higher than level B2 of Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)
- Photocopy of passportPhotocopy of the photo page of your valid passport
- (3) Where to submit the documents

7. Notes

- ① Omission of any one of the above documents will result in the rejection of application.
- 2 You will be notified of the Tokai University selection results at end-February 2025(provisional), and



the final result from MEXT at end-June 2025 (provisional).

- 3 Each grantee needs to obtain national health insurance on your own after arrival in Japan.
- Information regarding the MEXT Scholarship Students (name, gender, date of birth, nationality, accepting university/graduate school/undergraduate school, field of specialty, period of enrolment, career path after completion of scholarship, contact information [address, telephone number, e-mail address]) may be shared with other relevant government organizations for the purpose of utilization for international students programs implemented by the Japanese Government (support during period of study in Japan, follow-up surveys, improvement of the international student system). Information regarding MEXT Scholarship Students (excluding date of birth and contact information) may be included in publicity materials prepared by the Japanese Government for promoting the acceptance of international students in Japan, particularly in order to introduce former MEXT Scholarship Students who are playing active roles in countries around the world.
- ⑤ A grantee will be ineligible for a scholarship if he/she was expelled from Japan in the past and a "Student" visa cannot be granted to him/her by the designated date of arrival in Japan.
- ⑥ International students selected for scholarships need to take and pass the examination for International Admission to Tokai University. Information about the procedure will be provided separately.

8. Privacy Policy

Personal information collected by Tokai University during the admissions process will be used as follows:

- In a series of administrative operations from application to admission, such as admission selection and student ID issuance, and various communications and notifications, and statistical tabulation (including use for education improvement and academic research at the University).
- For necessary services and announcements such as class registration, student lists, academic records, school registration, issuing of certificates, screening for scholarships, health exams, various applications for registration, and use of school facilities (including usage for the purpose of educational improvement and academic research).

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1. 概要

東海大学大学院工学研究科機械工学専攻は日本政府文部科学省の「令和5年度『国費外国人留学生の優先配置を行う特別プログラム』」に採択されました(2024年度より3年間)。日本政府文部科学省は日本政府奨学金により、東海大学大学院工学研究科において、機械工学専攻に関する指導を受ける外国人留学生を、下記のとおり募集します。

2. 出願資格および条件

(1) 国籍

日本政府と国交のある国の国籍を有すること。申請時に日本国籍を有する者は、原則として募集の対象とはならない。ただし、申請時に日本以外に生活拠点を持つ日本国籍を有する二重国籍者に限り、渡日時(受入大学における学籍等発生時)までに外国の国籍を選択し、日本国籍を離脱する予定者は対象とする。なお、以下の重点地域からの外国人留学生を優先する。

東南アジア(10ヵ国):シンガポール、ブルネイ、ミャンマー、ラオス、タイ、カンボジア、ベトナム、マレーシア、フィリピン、インドネシア

(2) 年齢

研究留学生:原則として 1990 年4月2日以降に出生した者。

上記年齢要件の例外は国籍国の制度・事情(兵役義務・戦乱による教育機会の喪失等)により 資格年齢時に応募できなかった者と文部科学省が判断した場合に限られる。個人的事情(経済 状況、家族の事情、健康状態、大学又は勤務先の都合等)は一切認めない。

(3) 学歴

日本の大学院修士課程・博士課程(前期)又は博士課程(後期)の入学資格を有する者(入学時点でこの条件を満たす見込みの確実な者を含む)。

(4) 専攻分野

大学において専攻した分野又は関連した分野とし、受入大学で研究が可能な分野であること。

(5) 語学能力

日本語又は英語のいずれかの能力を有する者として、以下のいずれかの条件を満たす者。

● 日本語

- ① 日本語能力試験(JLPT)のレベル N2 以上に合格している者。
- ② 日本の大学院修士課程・博士課程(前期)又は博士課程(後期)への入学資格を満たす教育課程を、日本語を主要言語として修了した者。



③ ①相当以上の日本語能力を有していると受入大学において判断できる者。

● 英語

- ① 英語におけるヨーロッパ言語共通参照枠 (CEFR) の B2 相当以上の資格・検定試験のスコアを有している者。
- ② 日本の大学院修士課程・博士課程(前期)又は博士課程(後期)への入学資格を満たす教育課程を、英語を主要言語として修了した者。
- ③ ①相当以上の英語能力を有していると受入大学において判断できる者。

(6) 使用言語

授業および研究指導は、主として英語で行う。

(7) 健康

日本留学について心身ともに支障がないと大学が判断した者。

(8) 渡日時期

原則として2025年9月1日から9月15日までの間に渡日可能な者。

やむを得ない事情があると文部科学省が判断した場合を除き、指定された期間最終日までに渡日できない場合は採用を辞退すること。また、自己の都合により、上記の所定の期間外に渡日する場合は、渡日旅費を支給しない。

(9) 查証・在留資格

渡日前に原則として国籍国所在の在外公館で「留学」の査証を新規取得し、新規に取得した「留学」の在留資格で入国すること。新規に「留学」の査証を取得せずに渡日した場合は、奨学金の支給停止となるので注意すること。なお、日本政府として入国前結核スクリーニングを実施する国があるため、査証取得にあたっては必ず国籍国所在の在外公館の指示に従うこと。

※国内推薦者の査証・在留資格について

現在の在留資格が「留学」となっていない者については、必ず、受入大学における学籍等発生時までに日本の地方出入国在留管理官署で「留学」の在留資格に変更手続きを行うこと。既に他の在留資格(「永住者」、「定住者」等)を有している場合であっても「留学」に変更の上、日本政府(文部科学省)奨学金留学生として課程を開始する必要がある。なお、日本政府(文部科学省)奨学金留学生の身分終了後に改めて「永住者」又は「定住者」の在留資格を申請しても当然には認定されない可能性があることを理解すること。在留資格を「留学」に変更せずに日本政府(文部科学省)奨学金留学生として学籍開始となった場合は、奨学金支給停止事項に該当するので注意すること。

また、現在の在留資格が「留学」の者については在留期間満了前に更新手続きを行うこと。なお、在籍大学等に変更がある場合は、出入国管理及び難民認定法第 19 条の 16 に基づく届出を漏れなく行うこと。

(10) 対象外

次に掲げる事項に一つでも該当する者については対象外とする。採用以降に判明した場合には 辞退すること。

- ① 現役軍人又は軍属の資格の者。
- ② 文部科学省又は受入大学の指定する期日までに渡日できない者。



- ③ 過去に日本政府(文部科学省)奨学金留学生であった者(学籍発生後辞退者を含む)。ただし「研究留学生」に応募を希望する者で、以下のいずれかに該当する場合はこの限りではない。なお、文部科学省学習奨励費(MEXT Honors Scholarship)は日本政府(文部科学省)奨学金留学生にあたらないため、過去に受給歴があっても応募可能。
 - 奨学金支給最終月の翌月から奨学金支給開始月までに3年以上の学業又は職務経歴がある者。
 - 最後に受給した日本政府(文部科学省)奨学金が日本語・日本文化研修留学生(帰国後に在籍大学を卒業した又は卒業見込みの者に限る。)、日韓共同理工系学部留学生、ヤング・リーダーズ・プログラム留学生のいずれかであった者。
 - 日本政府(文部科学省) 奨学金(大学推薦・特別枠)の学部生として学士の学位を取得 (又は取得見込みの者) した者。
- ④ 日本政府(文部科学省) 奨学金制度による他の 2025 年度奨学金支給開始のプログラムと の重複申請をしている者。
- ⑤ 奨学金支給開始後(受入大学における学籍等発生後)に日本政府(文部科学省)以外の機関(自国政府機関を含む)から奨学金を受給することを予定している者。
- ⑥ 「卒業見込みの者」であって、所定の期日までに学歴の資格及び条件が満たされない者。
- ⑦ 申請時に二重国籍者で、渡日時(受入大学における学籍発生時)までに日本国籍を離脱したことを証明できない者。
- ⑧ 申請時から日本以外での研究活動(インターンシップ、フィールドワーク等)や休学等を 長期間予定している者。
- ⑨ 学位取得を目的としない者。

(11) その他

日本留学中、日本の国際化に資する人材として、広く地域の学校や地域の活動に参加することで、自国と日本との相互理解に貢献するとともに、卒業後も留学した大学と緊密な連携を保ち、卒業後のアンケート調査等にも協力する他、帰国後は在外公館等が実施する各事業に協力すること等で、自国と日本との関係の促進に努める者を採用する。

3. 奨学金支給期間

原則として、2025年9月より2年間支給する。

- ※支給には一定の条件がある。
- ※渡日後、奨学金を受給するまでに1か月~1か月半程度必要なため、当座の生活資金として、 差し当たり必要となる費用を最低2,000米ドルほど用意すること。

4. 奨学金等

(1) 奨学金

在籍課程に応じ以下の額を支給する。特定の地域において、修学・研究する者には、月額 2,000円又は 3,000 円を月額単価に加算する。なお、日本政府の予算状況により各年度で金額は変更される場合がある。大学を休学又は長期に欠席した場合、その期間の奨学金は支給されない。

(2) 旅費

文部科学省は、原則として旅行日程及び経路を指定して航空券を交付する。ただし、国内推薦者については航空券を交付しない。航空券は、渡日する留学生の居住地最寄りの国際空港(原則、国籍国内)から受入大学が通常の経路として日本国内で使用する国際空港までの下級航空券とする。なお、渡日する留学生の居住地から最寄りの国際空港までの国内旅費、空港税、空港使用料、渡航に要する特別税、日本国内の旅費(航空機の乗り継ぎ費用を含む。)、旅行保険料、携行品・別送手荷物に関わる経費等は留学生の自己負担とする。また、国籍国に在外公館が所在していない場合及び、国籍国に所在する日本の在外公館が閉館している等の理由により、査証申請のため第三国へ立ち寄り渡日する者又は国籍国からの直行便がない者については、立ち寄り国内の旅費、宿泊費等は自己負担とし、国籍国から立ち寄り国までの航空券並びに立ち寄り国から受入大学が通常の経路として日本国内で使用する国際空港までの下級航空券のみを文部科学省が交付する。「留学生の居住地」は原則として申請書に記載された「現住所」とするが、渡日前に国籍国内で転居する場合は、申請書「渡日前住所」欄に記載された住所を「居住地」として認め、最寄りの国際空港からの航空券を手配する。なお、査証申請のための第三国立ち寄り等を除き、自己都合により国籍国外から渡日する場合は航空券を交付しない。

② 帰国旅費

文部科学省は、原則として大学を卒業又は修了し、上記「2. 奨学金支給期間」に定める奨学金支給期間終了月内に帰国する留学生に対し、本人の申請に基づき航空券を交付する。航空券は、受入大学が通常の経路として使用する国際空港から当該留学生が帰着する場所の最寄りの国際空港(原則、国籍国内)までの下級航空券とする。帰国する留学生の日本での居住地から最寄りの国際空港までの旅費、空港税、空港使用料、渡航に要する特別税、国籍国内の旅費(航空機の乗り継ぎ費用を含む。)、旅行保険料、携行品・別送手荷物に関わる経費等は留学生の自己負担とする。なお、自己都合及び下記「4. 奨学金支給停止事項」の事由により奨学金支給期間終了月前に帰国する場合は帰国旅費を支給しない。

また、奨学金支給期間終了後も引き続き日本に滞在する場合(例:日本での進学、就職)、 一時帰国する際の帰国旅費は支給しない。

(3) 教育費

大学における入学検定料、入学金及び授業料等は受入大学が負担すること。

※諸会費(学生健康保険互助組合費、同窓会費)は学生負担となる。

5. 奨学金支給停止事項

次の場合には、文部科学省は奨学金の支給を取り止める。また、これらに該当した場合、それまで支給した奨学金の一部又は全ての返納を命じることがある。なお、処分が決定されるまでの間、奨学金の支給を止めることもある。

① 申請書類に虚偽・不正の記載があることが判明したとき。

- ② 文部科学大臣への誓約事項に違反したとき。
- ③ 日本の法令に違反し、無期又は一年を超える懲役若しくは禁錮に処せられたとき。
- ④ 大学における学則等に則り、懲戒処分として退学・停学・訓告及びこれらに類する処分を 受けた場合あるいは除籍となったとき。
- ⑤ 大学において学業成績不良や停学、休学等により標準修業年限内での修了が不可能である ことが確定したとき。
- ⑥ 「留学」の査証を新たに取得せずに渡日したとき又は「留学」の在留資格から他の在留資格に変更になったとき。国内推薦者の場合は、「留学」以外の在留資格で日本政府(文部科学省)奨学金留学生としての学籍開始となったとき又は「留学」の在留資格から他の在留資格に変更になったとき。
- ⑦ 他の奨学金(使途が研究費として特定されているものを除く。)の支給を受けたとき。
- ⑧ 採用後、進学に伴う奨学金支給期間延長の承認を受けずに上位の課程に進学したとき。
- ⑨ 当該大学を退学したとき又は他の大学に転学したとき。
- ⑩ 1年毎の各時点における学業成績係数が 2.30 又は大学が定める成績基準を下回ったとき。

裏面に氏名 (ブロック体)を明記すること。 (最近3か月以内に撮影した正面上半身・脱帽で明瞭なもの。大きさは、縦4cm×横3cm、枠なし、白黒・カラーともに可。)

- ④ 出願資格に係わる最終学歴の成績証明書(原本) レターヘッドを使用し厳封の上、割印または署名が必要。
- ⑤ 最終出身大学において優秀であることを証明する学業成績 レターヘッドを使用し厳封の上、割印または署名が必要。
- ⑥ 出願資格に係わる最終学歴の卒業(見込)証明書(原本) 卒業(修了)見込み等で受験し合格した者で、2025年9月30日までに大学院入学資格を取



得できなかったものは合格取り消しとなり入学資格を失います。

日本語又は英語のいずれかの条件を満たす者。

日本語:日本語能力試験(JLPT)のレベルN2以上に合格している者。

英語:英語におけるヨーロッパ言語共通参照枠(CEFR)のB2相当以上の資格・検定試験のスコアを有している者。

⑨ パスポートの写し

有効期限内のパスポートの顔写真のあるページの写し。
